Policy Document of Anti-Ragging

As per the Guidelines of UGC under the Act of 1956, which is modified as UGC regulations on curbing the menace of Ragging in Higher Educational Institutions, 2009, establishment of Anti-Ragging Cell is compulsory. The College always takes preventive measures to eliminate the scourge of Ragging among the Students and to provide them with Healthy Development, both Physical and Psychological. Anti Ragging Cell is constituted for the purpose and is instrumental in fulfilling the objectives mentioned below:

- To publicize to all Students and prevalent directives and the actions that can be I. taken against those indulging in ragging.
- To consider the complaints received from the Students and conduct enquiry II. and submit a report to the Anti- Ragging Committee along with punishment recommended for the offenders.
- To take all necessary measures for prevention of Ragging inside the Campus. III. IV.
- To offer Services of counseling and create awareness amongst the students. V.
- The policy for handling issues of Ragging is that the Anti-Ragging Committee shall promptly conduct a preliminary on the spot enquiry and collect details of the incident and these shall be immediately brought to the notice of the Principal. The Action should be completed, at the most, within 20 hours of receipt of information.

As per the order of Supreme Court of India and subsequent notification from University Grants Commission (UGC), ragging constitutes one or more of any intention by any Students or group of students on:

- Any act of Indiscipline, Teasing or Handling with Rudeness. 1.
- Any act that Prevents, Disrupts the Regular Academic Activity. 2.
- Any activity which is likely to cause Annoyance, hardship, Psychological Harm 3. or creates Fear or Apprehension.
- 4. Any Act of Financial Extortion or Forceful Expenditure.
- Any Act of Physical Abuse causing Assault, Harm or danger to Health. 5.
- Any Act of abuse by spoken words, emails, SMS or public insult etc. 6.
- Any Act of injury or infringement of the fundamental right to human dignity.

- Any Act of Wrongful Confinement, Kidnapping, molesting or committing unnatural offenses, use of criminal forces, trespass or intimidation.
- Any unlawful assembly or conspiracy to ragging.

Punishment to those Found Guilty

Any student or group of students found guilty of ragging in the campus or even outside the campus shall be liable to one or more of the following punishments:

1. Debarring from appearing in any sessional test /.*University Examination.

- 2. Suspension from attending classes and academic privileges.
- 3. Withdrawing scholarships and other benefits.
- 4. Suspension from the college.
- 5. Cancellation of the admission.
- 6. Withholding the results.
