For examples, if the total score for a publication is 10 (say), then the first/Principal author, the corresponding author, supervisor, co-supervisor and mentor would get 6 points each and the other authors would get 4 points each.

\*\* API Score for III E(ii) will be claimed solely by the author who participated and presented the paper (oral/poster) however if a paper presented in conference/ seminars is published in the form of proceedings the points would accrue for the publication (III) (a) and not under presentation III(e) (II)
